C.R.&Y.C. Berthing Policy

The aim of this policy is to avoid regulation or confrontation and to create an easy and amicable way of managing the club to the benefit of all members.

Civility and consideration is paramount in all dealings in regard to berths and use of club premises.

1. Priority will be given to regular users of the river and lake.
2. Boat not in regular use will be removed from the water in order to facilitate item 1. Where possible members are requested to adopt a policy of launch and retrieve.
3. No person will berth a boat in an empty slot without the permission of the Captain or Caretaker (such boat may be removed from the water).
4. All boats will be maintained in a seaworthy and presentable condition according to the rules.
5. When lifting an unused boat from the water the club will take due care and diligence. Notwithstanding this, all lifts according to the rules are at the owner's risk.
6. Trailers to be maintained in a roadworthy condition, or trailer will be disposed of.
