C.R.&Y.C. Environmental Policy

The committee has decided to introduce this policy due to the actions of a few members who take the facilities of the club for granted.

- All members are required to remove any rubbish they generate from the club grounds.
- A system of segregation will be introduced i.e. recyclable, compostable and landfill.
- The use of automatic or manual bilge pumps on the waterway adjacent to the club premises or anywhere within the club grounds must be supervised at all times.

Penalties/Fines will ensue for the following actions.

1. No pumping of bilges while boats are stored on land. Fine €100
2. No pollution of waterways or grounds with oily water. Fine €100
3. No leaving of old batteries or waste oil drums on club grounds. Fine €50
4. All paint cans etc to be brought home and properly disposed of. Fine €50

All fines be they statutory or otherwise will be the responsibility of the polluter.
