



C.R. & Y.C. Environmental Policy

Regulation: 2023-01

In order to maintain CRYC Grounds in good order and to comply with Statutory Health & Safety Regulations, the CRYC Committee shall enforce the following Environmental Policy:

- All members are required to remove any rubbish they generate from the club grounds. No items are to be left on club grounds (including sheds), including: Paint Cans / Batteries / Oil Drums / General Waste.
- Members shall not expel any bilge liquid that contains any traces of oil / fuel or any other environmentally damaging liquid
- Members, who are working on engines (or any object which may expel oil / fuel / environmentally damaging liquid) shall place underneath a suitable absorbent pad and shall dispose of in an environmentally friendly way when complete.
- Members shall not leave any residue / stains of any oil / fuel / environmentally damaging liquid (including paint / resin etc.) on any of the grounds of CRYC (including Shed / Concrete / Stones)
- Members shall not use drainage systems in C.R. & Y.C. to dispose of anything other than water. No oil / fuel / environmentally damaging liquid (even trace amounts) shall be poured down C.R. & Y.C. drains (There is an oil disposal bund at rear of grounds)
- Members using the Shed (or any other area) of CRYC grounds for maintenance works shall remove all items and leave the area clean on a DAILY basis, unless explicitly previously agreed by the Captain / Caretaker / Committee
- Members shall not use Tearoom sink to wash dirty / oily / greasy hands. A Hand-wash Station is located behind the shed.
- If the Captain / Caretaker / Committee deem any area to be left in an un-tidy manner, Captain / Caretaker / Committee are empowered to have any items removed.
